In Towns County: Allison Drive, Azalea Cove, Chatuge Shores Road, Daisy Lane & Meadow Brooke Lane, Enchantment Way, Furman Gribble Road near Meadow Brooke, Harris Ridge Road, Lake Lane and Hytop Road, Sunset Bay Condos, Thunder Oak Drive, and Upper Bell Road in Bell Meadows.
